



PTG BOARD POLICY 2-1

POLICY TITLE: Classes of Membership, Setting of Fees and Ticket Prices

BACKGROUND

The Peterborough Theatre Guild is operated by its members on a voluntary basis and membership has been traditional as a means of belonging to the club; and memberships support the PTG operating expenses in order that our members can continue to enjoy the advantages of a theatre group. The Guild works mainly from the revenue of established membership fees to provide theatre to the community as a whole.

POLICY STATEMENT

This policy establishes memberships and the setting of membership fees and ticket prices.

POLICY

1. The two classes of membership are Subscription and Working
2. Both classes have voting privileges and may serve on the Board of Directors or Production Executive.
3. Working members are only entitled to free tickets for productions that they work on.
4. Changes in Membership structure, package names, and prices are recommended by the Board of Directors and must be approved at the Annual General Meeting. There shall be a savings for Members over individual ticket prices.
5. The price of an individual (non-member) ticket for all productions shall be determined by the Board. The Board may set children's, student, senior, family, other special or group rates at its discretion.
6. Annual membership subscription fees shall be published on the PTG website and posted at the Guild Box Office.

MONITORING:

Annual membership subscription fees shall be monitored/administered by the Box Office volunteers.
